EUROSKILLS SPA-FRANCHORCHAMPS 2012 - DIE EM DER BERUFE IN **BELGIEN**



This October, right before the WorldSkills 2013 here in Leipzig, young and highly qualified trainees from all over Europe compete in their professional discipline at the EuroSkills 2012 in Belgium. The venue is located at the world-renowned race tracks of the Spa-Francorchamps. Just there, from October 4th to 6th, the third European Competition of craftsmen and -women, technicians and technology

experts will take place. After the preceding Portugal (EuroSkills Lissabon 2010) and in anticipation of the EuroSkills 2014 in Lille, SkillsBelgium is organizing this European event:

450 participants from 28 countries compete in 47 professional disciplines on 40,000 square meters of competition and exhibition venue, with the support and help of 500 volunteers and 1,000 advisors.

The German Team is represented by 24 competitors and they all will do their very best to achieve a medal in their skill.
