ELECTRICITY

The standard mains voltage in Germany is 230 volts. Equipment that is not designed for 230 volts requires a transformer. The socket outlets used in Germany are normally of the "Schuko" type. This means that adapters are needed for equipment with American or Japanese plugs, for example.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Media may take photos and film from outside the workshop area without any prior approval. Note: accreditation badges must be visible. If a person is acting suspiciously then they may be guestioned by an Expert/s – in this case they are requested to comply fully with the Expert/s questions and requests.
- 2. No media can enter a workshop area during the Competition.

- 3. No media can enter a workshop area during breaks in the Competition without the permission of the Chief Expert for that skill. Specific 'shots' or 'angles' are to be organized in discussion with the Chief Expert, the compatriot Expert and the Competitor.
- 4. No media can communicate with a Competitor without the permission of the Chief Expert and the compatriot Expert.
- 5. No media is to enter the 'personal space' (i.e. do 'close-ups') of a Competitor without the permission of the Chief Expert and the compatriot Expert.

6. Media must respect any signage at the skills about flash photography as some skills do not allow flash photography as specific times for the safety of the Competitors.

Any Media who do not comply with this are at risk of having their accreditation revoked.
